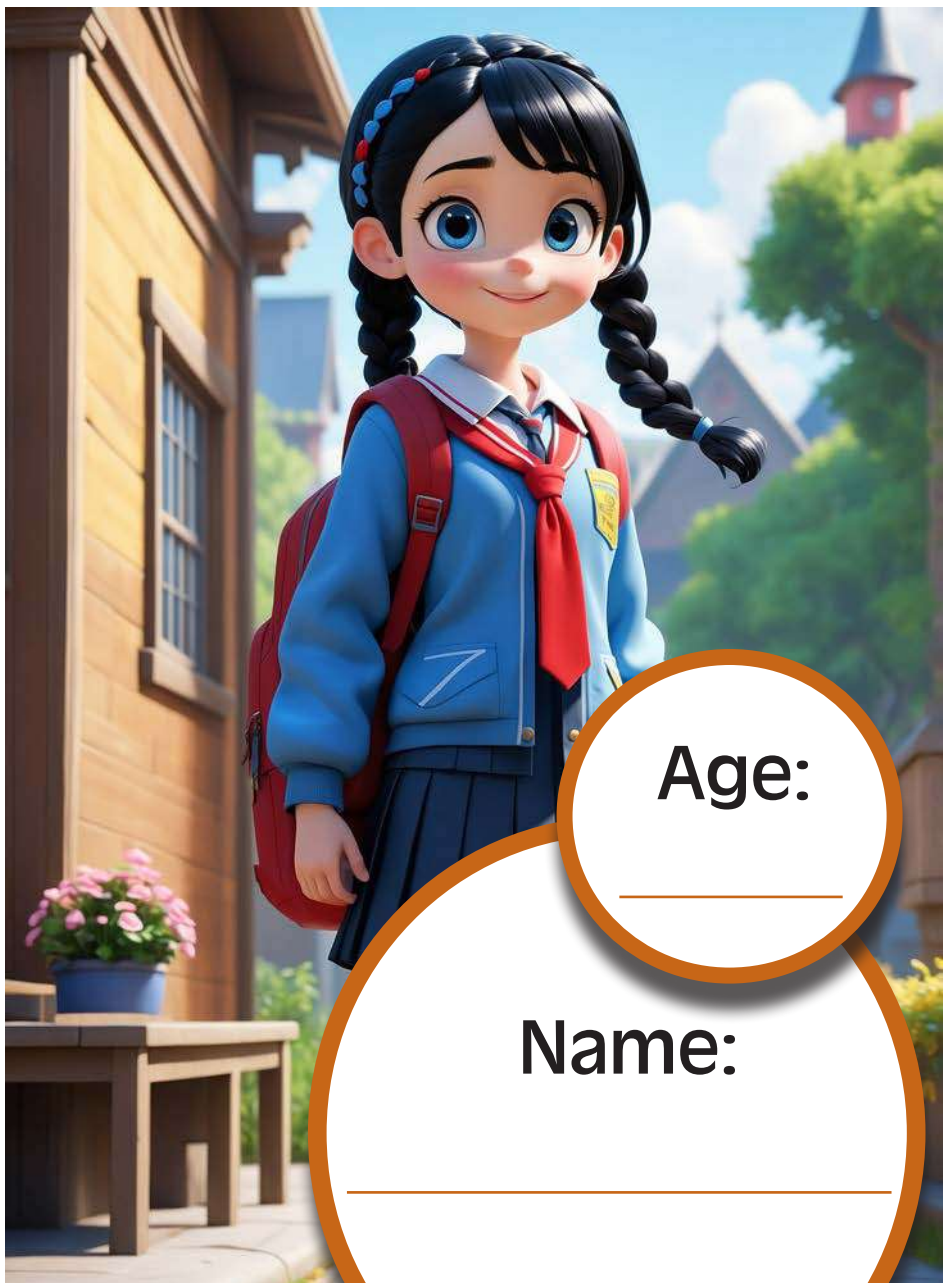

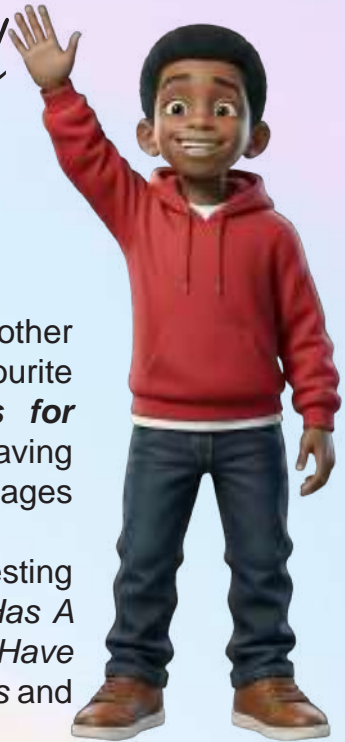

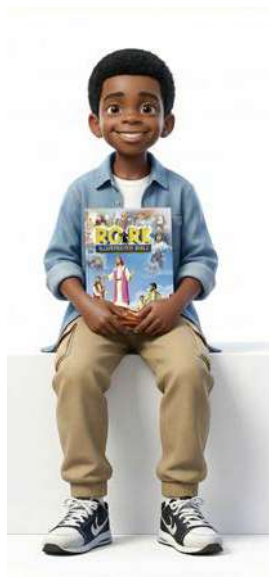

## THE POWER OF OUR OFFERINGS

1. God accepts offerings given with a right heart. God is happy when we give to Him with love (Genesis 4:4). The heart matters first.
2. God loves cheerful giving. He wants us to give with joy, not sadly or angrily (2 Corinthians 9:7). Attitude is key.
3. God notices and values small offerings. He looks at the heart of the giver, not the size of the seed (Mark 12:41-44). Even the smallest gift counts when given sincerely.
4. Giving to the Lord shows our love and honour for Him. When we give to God, we honour Him with what we have (Proverbs 3:9). Giving is an act of reverence.
5. Giving is part of our worship to God. When we give, we are worshipping the Lord (Hebrews 13:16).

6. Our offering is pleasing to the Lord. (Philippians 4:18). God delights in offerings given rightly.
7. Our giving helps God's house and God's work. Our offerings support God's servants and His work (1 Corinthians 9:13-14). Giving sustains ministry and mission.
8. Jesus taught us that giving is a blessing. The giver is more blessed than the receiver (Acts 20:35). Giving transforms the giver.
9. When we give, God gives back to us. Giving brings blessings in many ways and in great measure (Luke 6:38). Generosity opens the door to God's provision.
10. God releases great blessings when we bring our offerings to Him (Malachi 3:10). Obedience in giving brings abundant blessings.

Psalm 45:1

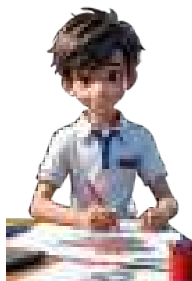
**My heart is overflowing with a good theme...

## What You Need To Know About The Christian Doctrines - Part 2.

I trust you had a great time learning new things from God's Word from our previous edition. In this edition, we'll be looking at What You Need To Know About The Christian Doctrines - Part 2.

It's going to be fun and exciting because you'll learn from God's Word the meaning of doctrine and some key Christian doctrines we have in the Bible. Let's get started...

### What Are Doctrines and Why Do They Matter? 1 Timothy 4:1; Philippians 3:17; Philippians 4:9

A doctrine means a clear set of beliefs, teachings, values, and instructions that people believe, learn, and practice. It helps us know what is right and how to live.

In Christianity, our doctrines come from the Bible. We do not make doctrines from human ideas, culture, feelings, or experiences. We believe what God shows us in His Word.

Our doctrines are from God. They give us a strong and safe pattern to follow, built on God's perfect and unchanging Word.

Doctrines are passed on by teaching, good examples, and training from those God has chosen to teach us (Philippians 3:17; Philippians 4:9). Not everyone can just make up a doctrine.

Following the Bible's pattern also keeps us safe from wrong

teachings that come from bad people or from the devil (1 Timothy 4:1).

## Some Important Christian Doctrines — Romans 5:17; Romans 5:21; Hebrews 6:1-2; Hebrews 9:12-14; Romans 1:17; 2 Corinthians 5:7

### **a. The Doctrine of Righteousness.**

Romans 5:21, *“For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.”*

This is one of the happiest truths in the Bible. It shows us what God did for us through Jesus.

Jesus never sinned, but God placed our sin on Him. And when we believe in Jesus, God makes us right with Him. This is called substitution: Jesus took our place.

If Jesus truly became sin for us, then we truly became righteous in Him. God did it!

### **b. Righteousness is a gift.**

Romans 5:17 says we receive the “gift of righteousness.” You don’t earn it; God gives it to you because you believe in Jesus.

Righteousness is also a nature—God’s own life in you. God is your Father, and just like children look like their parents, you now share His nature.

You cannot get “more” righteous after you are born again. Just like a baby is already 100% human, you are already 100% righteous in Christ the moment you’re saved.

Some people think they become righteous by doing good things. But the truth is, you do good things because you are already righteous inside.

You’re righteous now. God has given you the power to choose what is right and say no to what is wrong.

What you have to do each day is walk in your righteous nature, which means living by God’s Spirit.
